



CMNN COVID-19 Safety Plan

The Children's Museum of Northern Nevada works diligently to provide a safe and clean environment for our visitors, members and staff. **The public is required to wear face coverings**, including children 3 years and older. Below is an outline of our ongoing cleaning procedures and protocols:

Registration Desk

- We have an online booking system in place through our Facebook: Children's Museum of Northern Nevada or our website: www.cmnn.org. Appointments are for 2 hour time slots, reservations are required.
- A plexiglass shield is present for the interface with Museum patrons
- Visitor Service Representatives will wear masks when interacting with the public

Exhibits

- All visitors will be asked to maintain 6 foot social distancing between exhibits
- All surfaces are wiped down daily
- All floors are mopped or vacuumed daily
- All kitchen toys will be sanitized between appointments, more often, if needed
- The climbing apparatus and slides are sanitized daily, sanitizer is required before entering
- Items that cannot be wiped are sprayed in between appointments with disinfectant spray
- All cloth, wood or otherwise porous items will not be in use until further notice
- Sanitizer is available to patrons throughout the Museum

STEM Lab

- All items in the STEM Lab are wiped down or sprayed with disinfectant in between appointments
- Seating will be 6 feet apart to follow protocols

Art Studio

- All tables will be sanitized after each use
- Seating will be at 6 foot intervals to follow social distancing protocols

Birthday Parties

- Birthday Parties are available from 4:00 to 6:00 pm Monday-Saturday and from 5:00 to 7:00 pm Sunday evenings. Reservations are required and can be made at www.cmnn.org. Parties are limited to 30 people total and the guests have the entire Museum to themselves.



Storytime Adventures

- Storytime is on Wednesdays and Saturdays at 10:00 am

Art Studio

- Art Studio is open daily.

Restrooms

- Restrooms are deep cleaned daily and spray disinfectant is applied between appointments or more often, if necessary
- Floors are sanitized daily after hours

Gift Shop/Snack Area

- Welcome desk will have a Plexiglas shield between the Visitor Service Representatives and visitors
- Visitor Service Representatives will wear face masks when interfacing with patrons
- Tables will be sanitized in between customers
- Disposable masks and gloves are available to all patrons upon request

General Cleaning

- All door handles, light switches, and commonly touched surfaces will be sanitized daily
